How does God view a submissive spirit in wives, verse 4?

How would you compare your attitude in relating to your husband with that of 1 Peter 3:1-5? What do you need to change in order to be more "precious" and "adorned" before God?

10. In 1 Peter 3:7, who is chosen by God as an example of how a woman is to relate to her husband in a godly way? What do you know about her?

Although she made some major mistakes, she still lived by faith and hope in God without fear. (See Hebrews 11:11) How does this help you desire God's ideal in your marriage?

11. Read Genesis 25:19-28; 27:1 – 28:1. Study Rebekah as a wife in light of what you have learned from Ephesians 5:21-33 as well as Proverbs 31:11-12. What conclusions can you draw?

What personal applications can you make from the study of Rebekah?
